I look forward to connecting with you throughout the weekend.

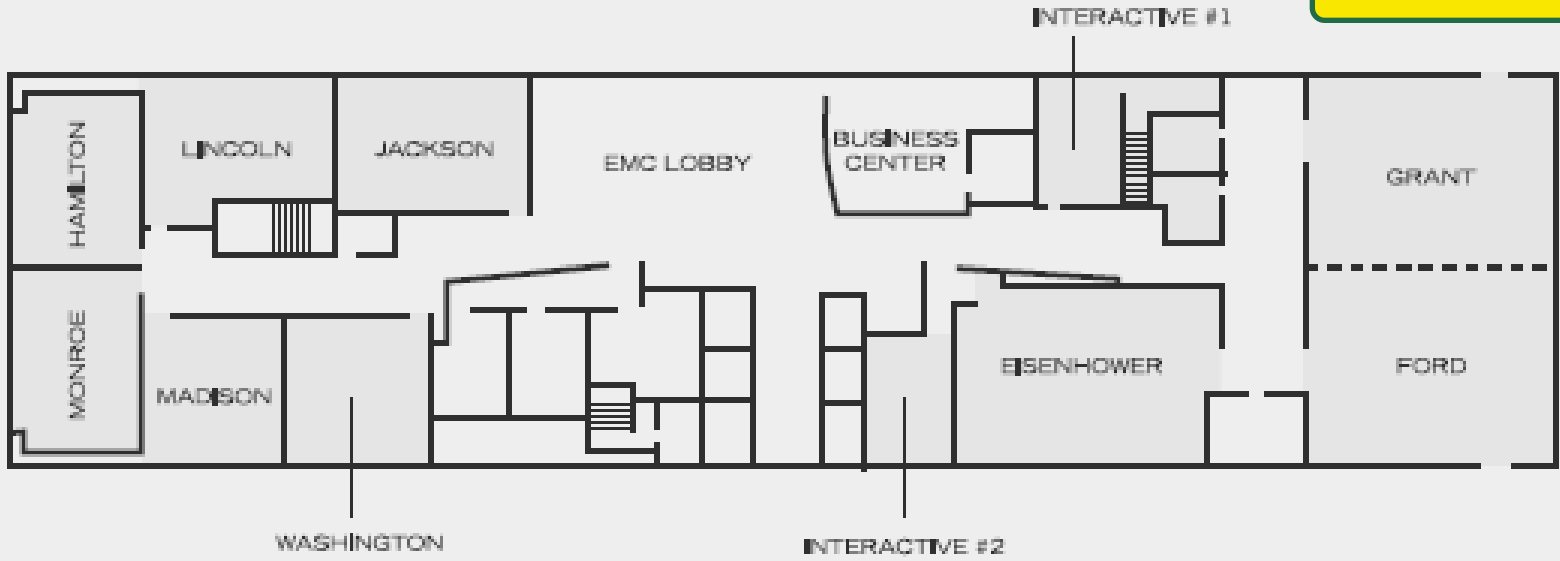

# Convention Map

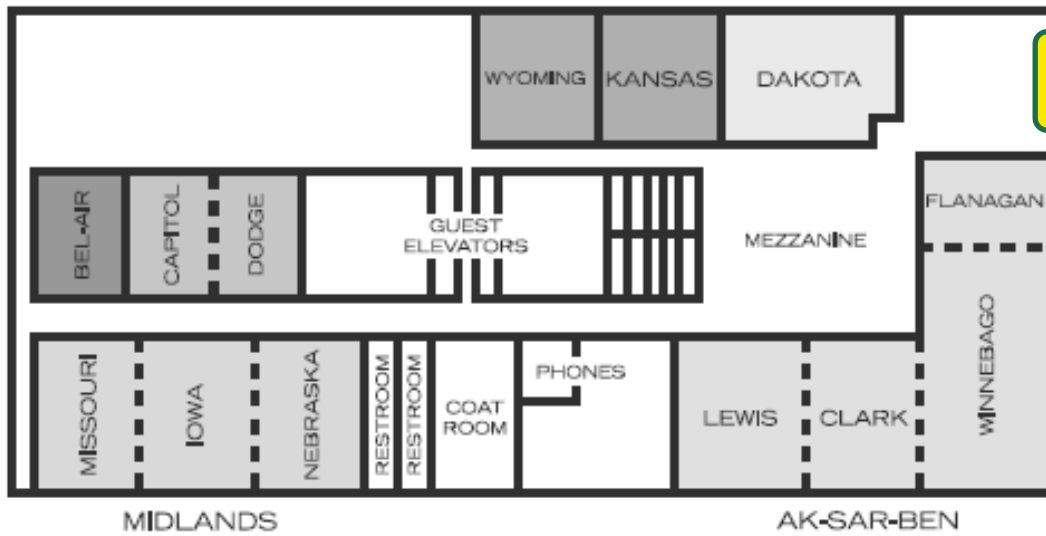

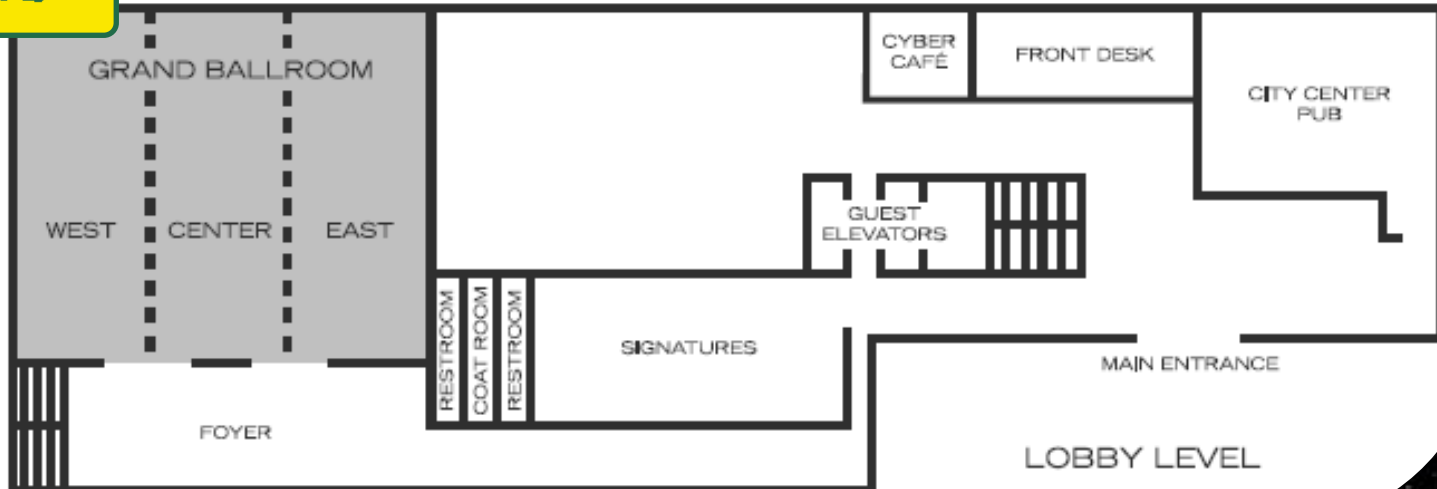


Floor 3

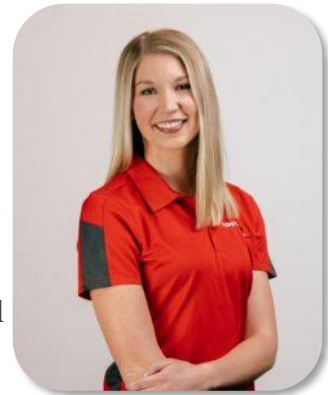
